NOTICE OF RACE

Organising Authority: Jervoise Bay Sailing Club Inc. (JBSC) in conjunction with the Nacra Association of Australia Inc.

1. Rules:

- 1.1. The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. The Prescriptions and Special Regulations Part 2 of Australian Sailing will apply.
- 1.3. Australian Sailing Special Regulations Part 2 Off the Beach Boats will apply. It will be the responsibility of all competitors to ensure that personal flotation devices comply with a standard equivalent to those listed in AS special Regulations 5.01 Personal Floatation Devices.
- 1.4. The International NACRA Class Rules as Amended for Australia will apply.

2. Advertising:

- 2.1. Competitors may be required to affix bow stickers displaying sponsor's names/logo(s). These items will be supplied by the Organising Authority and shall be affixed as prescribed in the Sailing Instructions.

3. Eligibility and Entry:

- 3.1. The regatta is open to all boats of the Nacra Classes.
- 3.2. All competitors shall be financial members of a Nacra Australia District.
- 3.3. Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and send it, together with the required fee to Nacra Western Australia as per the details on the form.
- 3.4. Late entries will be accepted under the following conditions: Entries received after 1st December 2017 will attract a \$50 late entry fee and entries will be accepted up to 1pm 30th December 2017.
- 3.5. Regatta T-shirts may not be guaranteed to late entries

4. Fees:

- 4.1. The series entry fee for a single person entry is \$290.00 (Jnr \$205.00)
- 4.2. The series entry fee for a two person entry is \$365.00 (Jnr \$295.00)
- 4.3. Late entry fee (after 1st December 2017) is an additional \$50

5. Schedule:

5.1. Registration:

Competitors need to register at the Jervoise Bay Sailing Club office Saturday 30th December 2017 between 11am and 1pm.

5.2. Measurement and inspection:

Competitors need to present Sails and battens at the Jervoise Bay Sailing Club office Saturday 30th December 2017 between 11pm and 1pm

6. Measurement and Equipment:

6.1. All boats and equipment shall comply with current class rules (The International NACRA Class Rules as Amended for Australia).

6.2. The event measurer reserves the right to inspect any boat and equipment at any time during the regatta to ensure compliance with the rules.

7. Sailing Instructions:

7.1. The sailing instructions will be available from the JBSC registration desk at Registration.

8. Venue:

8.1. The Regatta location is Jervoise Bay Sailing Club inc, 128 Woodman Point View , Coogee. WA 6166. (<http://www.jbsc.org.au/>)

- 8.2. The regatta will be sailed in the waters off Owen Anchorage directly north of the club house.

9. The Courses:

- 9.1. The course will be described in the sailing instructions and will be available at registration.

10. Penalty System:

- 10.1. For all classes, rule 44.1 is changed so that the two turn penalty is replaced by a one turn penalty.

11. Scoring:

- 11.1. One (1) Race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 11.2. When fewer than four (4) races have been completed, a boats series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 11.3. When four (4) to nine (9) races have been completed, a boats series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 11.4. When ten (10) races have been completed, a boats series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two (2) worst scores.
- 11.5. The Low point system of appendix A will apply.

12. Support Boats:

- 12.1. All coach/support boats shall register at the competitor's registration desk.
- 12.2. Coaches/support boats shall make themselves available at all times while afloat to assist the race committee in the case of an emergency or rescue, as directed in person by the relevant race officer or via VHF radio.
- 12.3. Unless so directed by the race committee, registered coach/support boats shall not enter the course area, starting area, finishing area or go closer than 50 metres to any boat racing between the Preparatory signal to start and until the last boat finishes or the race committee signals a postponement or abandonment. The penalty for failing to comply with these requirements may, after protest, be the disqualification of all boats associated with the infringing support personnel.

13. Radio Communication:

- 13.1. Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile phones and other mobile devices.

14. Safety Equipment:

- 14.1. While afloat each boat must have on board a righting line of minimum 10mm thickness and 4.5 meters in length.
- 14.2. While afloat competitors have to wear a type 2 PFD buoyancy aid.

15. Prizes:

- 15.1. The first crew of the official ranking list in each class will be declared the “Nacra National Champion”.
- 15.2. Prizes will be awarded to at least the first 3 place getters in each class.
- 15.3. Minimum 4 entries to form a class. For class’s with less than the required number you may be grouped together to form a miscellaneous class. The committee may award more prizes at their discretion.

16. Media rights:

- 16.1. By participating in the Nacra National Championship, a competitor automatically grants the Organising Authority and the sponsors to right to, in perpetuity, make, use and show, from time to time and at their discretion, any (still) motion pictures, live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the competitor and its material, during and after the Nacra National Championships without compensation.

17. Disclaimer of Liability:

- 17.1. Competitors will participate in the Nacra National Championship entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, “Decision to Race”. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for personal or material damage, injury or death, sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during or after the Nacra National Championships. The organizing authority disclaims any and all liability.

18. Insurance:

- 18.1. All boats shall carry public liability to the value of at least \$5 Million (Recommended \$10 Million).
- 18.2. All competitors who submit the Entry Form are deemed to have made a declaration that they hold such cover. Competitors may be required to provide details and evidence that they have such insurance in place at the time of entry.
